IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Please arrive about 15 minutes prior to the time printed on your ticket for access control and health and security checks.

Due to the popularity of the experience you might not be able to be accommodated if you arrive later than your ticket session.

Masks will be required by all guests aged 12+ prior to entry and throughout the experience. If you have forgotten your mask, a disposable mask will be available for purchase. Visitors will have their temperatures checked on arrival. Guests with a temperature reading of 37.5 degrees celsius or above will be asked to wait for 10 minutes and rechecked. Should their temperature read above 37.5 on the second check, they will not be permitted entry.

Individual visit times will vary, but you can anticipate spending 60 – 90 minutes. The main feature of the exhibition lasts 45 minutes.
