Canoelands is a suburb of northern Sydney and is 60 kilometres north of the Sydney central business district, in the local government area of Hornsby Shire and The Hills Shire.

Canoeland Orchard: (morning tea : own expense and pick-your-own fruit):



At Canoeland Orchard they sell fresh produce and their own honey, jams chutney, icecreams and jewellery. They also have a café (limited seating) where they serve coffee, snacks and drinks. You can enjoy morning tea (at your own expense) and then have free time to pick-your-own fruit. Fruits ready to 'pick-your-own': (season permitting) Nectarines, peaches and plums. Payment for all picked fruit: OWN EXPENSE.



Also available for purchase is Pa's Honey - Pa's Honey is available in all sizes up to 1kg. Canoelands Orchard now have over 50 hives and produce their own raw Honey. Pa started producing honey in a smaller scale as a bit of a hobby in his retirement. His granddaughter Kirra often asked "can I have some of 'Pa's Honey on my cereal?". After a few years and lots of learning the fresh raw honey he was producing has become a major part of the business. When the discussion came about the name for the label there was no better name than PA'S HONEY. Pa in the family relates to John Christie who is the second (out of 3) generation farmer and who has in fact still very involved in the business as taking on this new venture of sharing the amazing place the family live in and the products they work so hard to produce has become a new part of all their lives.
