The Australian Pioneer Village:





The Australiana Pioneer Village will absorb you into the atmosphere and activities of life over 100 years ago. Come and visit this slower lifestyle.

Built in the little township of Wilberforce, one of the 5 Macquarie towns, first settled in 1794 and situated 3 miles from historic Windsor.

The spirit of the Rose family lives on in Rose Cottage, the best point of the village, recognised as the oldest timber of dwelling in Australia and still standing on its original site. The Village is not a re-creation of early buildings but a street full of dwellings, shops etc, that have been moved from their original sites around the historic Hawkesbury district. The history surrounding many of the cottages and shops is fascinating.

The village tour starts at 10.30 – to be followed by a Tractor Ride around the village. You will also have free time to inspect the village.

Wisemans Ferry Bowling Club - Lunch:







Nestled in the heartland of the Hawkesbury River is the rustic Wisemans Ferry Bowling Club, situated only 60 kilometres north-west of Sydney CBD. Encircled by National Parks the club overlooks the magic waters of the Hawkesbury and surrounding cliffs which offer a magnificent view from the large dine-on verandah.

Watkins Orchard (pick-your-own mandarins):







Come and meet the Watkins - Mark, Ann & Isaac at the Farm.

The varieties of mandarins that they grow are: Imperial, a very popular variety, extra juicy and extra large - an old family favourite is the Emperor mandarin, grown for many generations, easy to peel with a great flavour.

You will be provided with a bag to pick your mandarins at no cost to you. If you wish to pick more than one bag of mandarins, then it would be at your own expense.
