Dolphin Watch Cruise aboard the HV Surprise - Tamboi Queen Cruisers

Enjoy a one and half hour dolphin watch cruise. The experienced skipper will tell us all about the dolphins and the Port in an informative and fun way. The vessel is fully licensed (at own expense), bottomless tea and coffee is available through the cruise.

Hunter Region Botanic Gardens:

The gardens were established in 1986 to grow, study, conserve and promote plants, particularly plants of the Hunter region.

The gardens display primarily Australian native plants with 30 hectares of themed gardens, over 3000 living specimens.

Apart from a botanic resource, it protects 105 hectares of mature forests, woodlands and wetlands in its conservation zones. This includes protection of wildlife including five species of rare, endangered and vulnerable fauna and seven protected plant species.

Lunch will be served at the Café and then you will have a chance to have some free time in the garden.
