<u>Can I enter Australian Museum with my exhibition ticket?</u> Yes. Your timed entry ticket to the Alexander the Great: 2000 years of treasures exhibition also entitles you entry to Australian Museum's other galleries and permanent exhibitions on the same day that the exhibition ticket is valid for. If you choose to visit the museum's other spaces before your timed ticket entry to the exhibition, please make sure you arrive at the exhibition at the time on your ticket.

How long does it take to see the exhibition? It is estimated that the average visit to the exhibition will be 75-90 minutes in a self-guided manner.

<u>Is there a restriction to how long I can spend in the exhibition</u>: While entry to the exhibition must be within the time slot on your ticket, (in this case 11-11.30), you can spend as long in the exhibition as you like on the day. <u>Cost:</u>

- Children: under 5 free.
- Adults : \$15 per ticket* (a saving of \$9 as the Club is subsidizing an extra \$5 from the discounted group price ticket)
- Concession : \$11 per ticket* (a saving \$7 as the Club is subsidizing an extra \$5 from the discounted group price ticket) {* a max. of 2 tickets for both categories}
- Children (5-15 years): \$12
- Guests: Adults \$20 each. Concession \$16, Children (5-15 years) \$12.
