Australia's most extraordinary art event

The Archibald, Wynne and Sulman Prizes is an annual exhibition eagerly anticipated by artists and audiences alike.

The Archibald Prize, first awarded in 1921, is Australia's favourite art award, and one of its most prestigious. Awarded to the best portrait painting, it's a who's who of Australian culture – from politicians to celebrities, sporting heroes to artists.

The Wynne Prize is awarded to the best landscape painting of Australian scenery, or figure sculpture, while the Sulman Prize is given to the best subject painting, genre painting or mural project in oil, acrylic, watercolour or mixed media.

Each year, the trustees of the Art Gallery of NSW judge the Archibald and Wynne, and invite an artist to judge the Sulman. This year's judge is Lindy Lee.

Visit the exhibition to vote for your favourite portrait in the People's Choice award, and see the work of budding artists aged 5-18 on display in the Young Archies.

Art Gallery Road, The Domain, Sydney NSW 2000,

On the eastern side of Sydney's CBD, next to the Royal Botanic Gardens and the Domain, just down the road from St Mary's Cathedral.

Getting there on foot: About 5 minutes walk from Macquarie Street, across the Domain, or from

Hyde Park.

Bus 441: departs York Street side of Queen Victoria Building on the hour and every 20 minutes during the week and every 30 minutes on weekends and public holidays, and drops off right outside the Gallery.

Gallery.
