Cockatoo Island is a UNESCO world-heritage-listed island in the middle of beautiful Sydney Harbour. Hop on a ferry and explore the island for the day.

We will be taken on a guided tour which would engage with history at a pace. This dynamic highlights tour provides an overview of the Island's history, revealing stories and anecdotes about convict life and fascinating characters of the Island's colourful past.

The Island was off-limits for more than 100 years. It now invites you to experience firsthand its pivotal role in Australia's convict and shipbuilding history.

Cockatoo Island has a long and illustrious history dating back to the time of first settlement, playing a significant role in the development of Sydney and the nation. Once a convict prison, then an industrial school for girls and finally, Australia's biggest shipyard. Come and immerse yourself in the history of Cockatoo Island.
