Minnamurra Rainforest

The Minnamurra Rainforest Centre is a Multi-Award Winning Environmental Tourism destination, and is one of the best examples of subtropical and warm temperate rainforest which once extensively covered the Illawarra region. This rainforest is situated in Budderoo National Park. The Centre offers visitors the opportunity to experience the rainforest area via network of raised walkways and paved tracks. The 'Rainforest Loop Walk' is a 1.6 kms walk which you can walk at your leisure.

Wollongong Botanic Gardens – Free Time

The Wollongong Botanic Garden is host to an impressive array of exotic, adaptable and flowering plant life from Australia, and around the world. The Botanic Gardens were established in 1970. It hosts a broad range of exotic and local indigenous plants.

The Builders Club – Buffet lunch

Australian Motorlife Museum

Established in 1992 by a group of motoring enthusiasts and renamed Australian Motorlife Museum in 2007 this attraction provides an insight into the history of motoring including vehicles and memorabilia. These along with other exhibits including extensive and historically significant collections of gramophones and typewriters provide an intriguing snapshot into the process of the 20th century. The Museum also has a unique position in the tourism arena and has a national reputation within the heritage motoring community. The current collection comprises thousands of antique items and continues to grow at an astonishing rate.
