The variety of products and produce choices include: lollies, chocolates, wines, honey, fruit, veg, skin care, lavender products, jams and spreads, apple juice and meat. (Locations and type of products might vary on the day). A 2 course lunch and tea/coffee will be served at Picton Bowling Club.

Bellbird Cottage (Lakesland)

Bellbird Cottage is situated approximately 12km south west of Picton. They sell a large range of dolls, bears, badges, spoons, antiques and other collectables on display. There is also a display of an operational H.O. scale model railway.

The property at Bellbird Cottage include 1000 fruit trees - peaches, plums, nectarines and apricots. Fruit can be purchased from the shed when available.

Langdale Lavender and Olive Farm (Oakdale via Picton)

Visit a working olive and lavender farm, sample the products made on site such as Bath Salts, Body Rubs, lip salve, bath bombs, soaps, shampoo, body wash, Massage Oil and Dusting powder.

Mowbray Park Produce (Thirlmere)

Some fruit/veggies will be available for purchase from the local producers.
