**Jamberoo Action Park**

Eleven exciting action-packed rides and attractions.

Alpine Chairlift: Soar 300 meters up the mountain on the chairlift where the views from the top are stunning. On a clear day you can see as far as Kurnell to the north and Jervis Bay to the south.

Billabong Beach: Get dumped at Billabong Beach. Ideal for the young ones because they get to play in shallow pools dodging jets of water from huge make-believe critters like Charlie the Croc, Percy the Pelican and Freddie Frog. Settlers Shack is a real hit with the youngsters. A giant bucket dumps 200 liters of water from the roof of the Shack.

Don't forget waterproof nappies for your little ones

Jamberoo Express: A trackless train that travels around the Park moving guests who would rather ride than walk. The Express picks you up from the Park entrance and takes you to all the major attractions.

Rapid River: Designed for families who want the excitement of a ride on rubber rafts around a 250 meter water course offering bucking rapids, half meter high waves, cascading waterfalls and an aboriginal grotto.

St Augusta Golf: Have a round or two on the landscaped mini golf course. Try and beat par on this tricky course. It's great fun for the whole family, 18 Holes.

Thrill Rides

Bobsled: The perennial favourites. Two tracks, snake down the mountain where riders can reach high speeds on the experienced track. The second track caters for the less experienced riders – (children under 1.4m must be accompanied by an adult 16yrs or over).

LeMans: Race around the track and dream that you are a Formula One driver. An old favourite that keeps the adrenalin flowing - (children under 1.4m must be accompanied by an adult 16yrs or over).

Outback Bay: Catch the perfect wave at Outback Bay. This Wave Pool pumps out the swells. The latest multimillion dollar attraction is a giant 2.5 megalitre wave pool that is capable of pumping out waves of up to 1.5 meters. If catching a wave is not your scene, relax on the golden sand and watch the action – Children's lagoon.

Splash Out: Two giant body slides that twist and turn down the mountain and let you Splash Out into a pool at the end of the slides.

- Vertical Drop - 16m
- 100m long (fast)
- 90m long (beginners)
- Pool depth - 1.2m
- Water discharge 1000 gals/hour - 4546 Lt/hour
