Corbett Gardens

2013 celebrates Tulip Time's 53rd festival. As one of Australia's oldest and best loved flower festivals, Tulip Time continues to grow as the region's largest event. Corbett Gardens will again be mass planted with over 60,000 tulips and 25,000 annuals. This year's theme is "Brighter Futures". Within walking distance of the Gardens you will also be able to visit Tulip Time Street Fair.

Peppers Craigieburn Garden

A stunning rural property nestled on the outskirts of Bowral in the New South Wales Southern Highlands, Peppers Craigieburn possesses a reputation as one of the regions premier venues for accommodation, leisure stays, conferencing, weddings and retreats.

Reflecting the style and elegance of the original homestead, Peppers Craigieburn was originally built in 1887 and welcomed its first guests in 1910.
